

• Bass Line/ (Bass Loop x 1) (Sounds like "bum, bum, bum, ding-dong, ding-dong")

<u>Bass</u> (Entire Song) / <u>Uke Group 1</u> (Intro & Verses) / <u>Male Vocals</u> (Chorus & Breaks after Chorus)

Note: The first three notes (bum, bum, bum) is a triplet (fourth beat of the previous measure). The C note is the first beat.



(Uke Group 1: high- and low-G ukuleles O.K.)


<u>Hand Claps</u> (Verses & Last Chorus):







• <u>Piano Riff</u> - **Uke Group 2** (Verses Only - Lightly) (Just an extended Kazoo Sax Riff from above.)
