- **Bass Line/ (Bass Loop x 1)** (*Sounds like “bum, bum, bum, ding-dong, ding-dong”*)

Bass (Entire Song) / Uke Group 1 (Intro & Verses) / Male Vocals (Chorus & Breaks after Chorus)

Note: The first three notes (bum, bum, bum) is a triplet (fourth beat of the previous measure). The C note is the first beat.
